As of the 10th day of September, 2019, Independent School District No. 7, Kingfisher County, Oklahoma, has 2 General Obligation bond issue(s) outstanding:

\$675,000 Transportation Equipment Bonds of 2015, dated November 1, 2015 (\$350,000 outstanding in principal as of the 10th day of September, 2019); and

\$3,170,000 Building Bonds of 2016, dated July 1, 2016 (\$2,200,000 outstanding in principal as of the 10th day of September, 2019).

Construct, furnish, equip, and/or acquire improvements to convert the old middle school into a 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> Grade Center (Heritage Elementary, 600 S 9th, Kingfisher, Oklahoma) to include, but not be limited to: cabinets and millwork, doors, door frames and door hardware, windows, glass and glazing, drywalls, acoustical ceiling tiles, paint and sealants, specialties, kitchen equipment, plumbing fixtures, and HVAC equipment	\$3,170,000.00
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
