



Kingfisher STARS Report Card 2017

Kingfisher STARS learning program provides services to children grades 3-8. All curricula and material is research based and of high quality. We closely adhere to standards set by the state of Oklahoma and grade level expectations. A typical afterschool session is two hours each day four days each week. At the beginning of each session students receive a snack and have homework time. Students in grades 3-8 are offered and five different twenty minute enrichment sessions each day. Morning sessions are offered to students in grades 3-4 who need extra help in curricular areas. Afternoon tutoring sessions are available for students 3-8 who need extra help in curricular areas. All tutors and teachers are certified or trained extensively in how children learn and the prescribed curriculum used.
